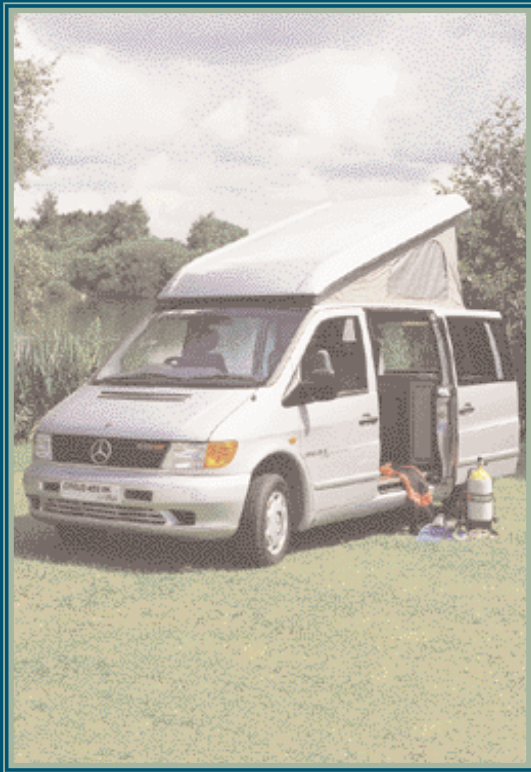

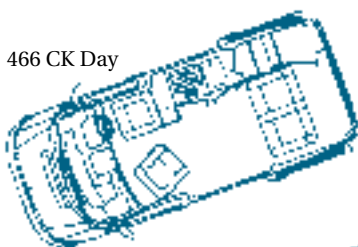

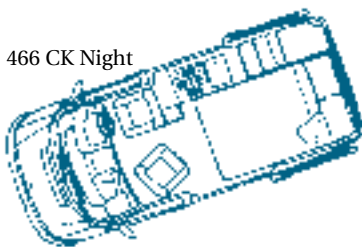

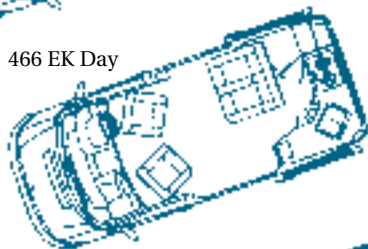
STANDARD LAYOUTS



466 CK Day



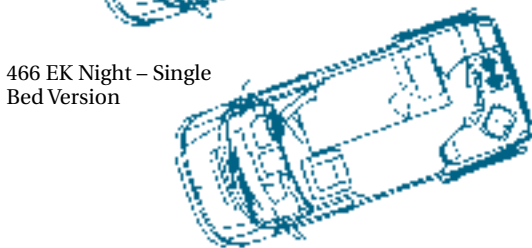
466 CK Night

WARRANTED FOR YOUR PEACE OF MIND

GUARANTEE

New base vehicles are covered by Mercedes' own 2-year European Breakdown Warranty and Roadside Assistance and "Get You Home" service. Base vehicle servicing is free for 12 months or 30,000 miles (whichever occurs first) at any participating Mercedes dealer and thereafter the vehicle requires servicing every year or 14,000 miles (whichever occurs first).

The habitation equipment, i.e. the motor caravan conversion, is covered by our comprehensive 12-month warranty and requires only a minimum amount of servicing every 12 months, which can be carried out by ourselves or any National Caravan Council Approved Centre or other suitably qualified service centre.

SPARES POLICY

Our spares policy* provides a 90% parts coverage for all of our products up to 10 years old and ensures consumables are available for vehicles up to 20 years old. In practice

we actually do better than our stated policy and can supply over 95% of parts for all of our products up to 20 years old.

PEACE OF MIND

We operate from our own freehold premises and have a strong asset base. Not all manufacturers can offer you this security. Your peace of mind is further assured by our client's money accounts policy where all deposits etc are held in a separate client's account and are not transferred out of this until you collect your new vehicle. 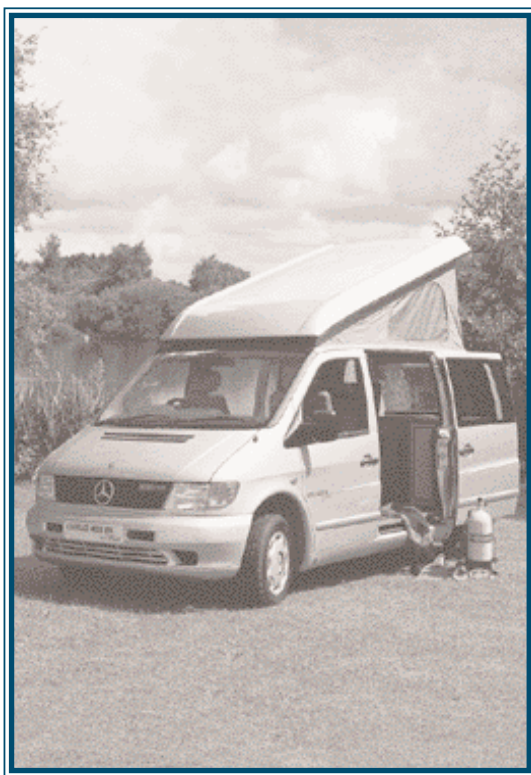

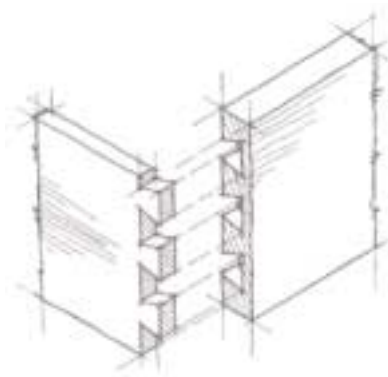

TECHNICAL DETAILS

REFRIGERATOR The fridge we fit has extremely low 12v current consumption, (up to a third of that of many others). So for wild camping you have the freedom to go anywhere. However when you are closer to civilisation, and 240v electricity is available the fridge will automatically switch itself over to run off the mains supply. It also has the benefit of low current protection – turning off if the charge in the battery drops too low, switching on again when the auxiliary battery is charged (for instance by running the vehicle engine). It also has a built-in accumulator which means that at the push of a button it can run for a further 8 hours (approximately) without using either the 12v battery or the 240v supply.

GAS SYSTEM The gas compartment will house 2 gas bottles so that you always have the reassurance of a spare gas bottle if you run out at an inconvenient time. These can be 2 x 3.9kg Propane Calorgas (or 4.5kg Butane) or 2 x 2.72kg Camping Gaz bottles. A regulator of your choice is included as standard.

ELECTRICAL SYSTEM Simple sophistication is possibly the best way to describe the electrical system. We feel that a charging system should be simple and effective and ours is just that. An auxiliary battery is fitted to power the "habitation" equipment ie. the 12v socket, water pump and reading lights etc and these circuits are completely separate from the main vehicle battery which operates the 12v vehicle electrics including the starter motor and vehicle instruments. So you don't have to worry about not being able to start the vehicle if you accidentally leave an internal light switched on.

The auxiliary battery is automatically charged when the vehicle is running; alternatively it can be charged when stationary by simply plugging the vehicle into a 240v supply. If you start the engine, the habitation equipment including the space heater is automatically turned off; so for instance you can't accidentally drive off with the water pump (or anything else) running that shouldn't be.

Neat, low power consumption, down-lighters are used to provide convenient light just where it is needed. A 12v socket, placed near the kitchen worktop, is ideal for charging mobile phones etc (please read manufacturers' instructions first) and 240v socket(s) are also fitted for when you are connected the mains electric.

WATER SYSTEM The water tank feeds the kitchen tap via an in-line water pump which is operated by a simple micro switch, but with our typical attention to detail we have also fitted a relay to ensure reliability and longevity of the switch mechanism. A conveniently positioned filler completes the water system.

RISING ROOF A rising roof is fitted which is both quickly and easily operated. If required an optional roof bed is available which folds down to provide sleeping accommodation for up to two children.
